Carlo Acutis,
"God's Influencer"
The Church of
Santa Maria
Maggiore in Assisi
is a meeting point
between worlds.
Built in the 11th
century, its
foundations are

pre-Christian, but today, when you enter this Church and turn right and go down the aisle, you will encounter a modern tomb. As you kneel in front of it, you'll see, through the glass, the body of a 15-year-old boy dressed in jeans, a sweatshirt and trainers just like any teenager.

This is Carlo Acutis, the teenager with a passion for computers and the Eucharist. This millennial (he was born in 1991), soon-to-be-saint, was born and baptised in London to non-practising Catholic parents. Yet, by the age of 3 he was already asking to visit churches to pray. When he was 9 he learnt computer programming,

"To always be close to Jesus, that's my life plan," he once said. Carlo didn't live his life on the screen. He learnt the name of foreign caretakers at his school and would always greet them personally by name every morning. He had a great love for the Eucharist, describing it as his "motorway to heaven."

"Why do people worry so much about their physical beauty but don't worry about the beauty of their souls?" Carlo often asked. He lived out this beauty as a person of great holiness on the inside and with the charity he showed in how he lived. He helped immigrants, beggars, the disabled, and the elderly. Even on his deathbed he didn't think of himself. When doctors asked if he was in great pain, he replied, "there are people who suffer much more than me." Carlo died aged 15 in 2006 of acute leukaemia. Such a short life, yet one that has left a formidable legacy! His life is a wonderful example of how faith takes nothing away from our desire to be free and happy.
